



Relativity Server to RelativityOne Migration: Team Roles & Responsibilities

Successful migrations start with early, collaborative planning between your team and Relativity. In our experience, customers see the best results when they align around a core set of roles. Depending on your team structure, individuals may take on multiple responsibilities.

- **Data Migration Champion:** An informed and motivated leader who sets priorities, drives momentum, and helps overcome internal obstacles to meet deadlines.
- **Technical Lead:** A team member responsible for coordinating subject matter experts within the organization to optimize the Relativity Server environment, ensure network reliability, manage the installation of required applications across workstations, VMs, and agent servers, and identify efficient methods for data migration from the organization.
- **Data Migration Project Lead:** A team member who partners closely with Relativity to guide the project, offer feedback, and help solve challenges.
- **Data Migration Assistants:** Individuals responsible for migrating workspaces to RelativityOne, addressing any issues with Relativity's support team, and performing validation once the workspace is restored in RelativityOne.

Pilot data migration	Select sample workspaces that will test the migration plan.	1 to 2 hours
	Train on RelativityOne data migration products.	2 to 3 hours
	Run sample workspaces through the full workflow.	6 to 8 hours
	Document performance of sample workspaces.	1 hour
	Finalize the migration plan and strategy.	1 hour
Migration wave	Migrate workspaces.	10 to 40 hours per week
	Attend weekly check-ins with your Relativity migration specialist.	15 to 25 minutes per week
